

## Non-Profit Space Application

Policy on Space for Non-Profit Organizations at the Camarillo Certified Farmers Market:

The Camarillo Certified Farmers Market (CCFM) will provide one space on Saturdays for use by one non-profit organization on a first-come first-served basis, based on the following requirements and provisions.

- 1. A representative of the non-profit organization shall request use of the space from the Market General Manager, Bill Frank (<u>farmersmarket@lmvna.org</u> or (805) 469-1526).
- 2. The non-profit organization shall not sell anything in competition with Farmers Market vendors or outside of the realm of approved CCFM products.
- 3. The non-profit organization must provide its own pop-up cover (no larger than 10 ft. by 10 ft.), table, chairs, etc.
- 4. The Market General Manager shall issue a confirmation of reservation to the approved non-profit organization, which must be presented at the Camarillo Certified Farmers Market on the approved Saturday prior to setting up in the non-profit space.
- 5. Such space may be pre-empted for use by Livingston if necessary.
- 6. The decision of the Market General Manager shall be final.
